Please use the following format:

- Word Document
- Font type: Times New Roman
- Line spacing: 1.5
- Font size: Body of text: 12pt
- Font size: Main heading 14pt bold, sub headings 12pt bold
- Maximum No of Words 7,000
- References not included in word count
- Text in English
- Inclusion of Photographs: Photographs can be included in Word Documents with text as part of an illustrated story
- Footer: Each page should include page numbers and date
- Header: Each page should include author(s) names and email contact
- Publications e.g. booklets can be sent as PDF docs
- Referencing: Authors should use the Harvard system for references explained in [http://libweb\(anglia.ac.uk\)/referencing/harvard.htm](http://libweb(anglia.ac.uk)/referencing/harvard.htm)
- Lesson plans and teacher resources/worksheets do not need to follow the above format
